## **Report**

The main changes and activities affecting the Stichting in 2008 are described below:

- On April 10, 2008, the Chief Executive Officer of Shell, Jeroen van der Veer, performed the official opening of the Archive Centre at the Hague town hall.
- The Source book: 'An Expatriate Social History, 1927 – 2007' with the subtitle 'Shell Lives Unshelved' was published by the Stichting in April 2008.
- A new website of the Archive Centre was launched mid 2008.
- Workshops were held in the fourth quarter;
- The registration process of archive collections in CALM was accelerated by the help of a temporary assistant archivist.
- The network of the Stichting was extended with many contacts and new external relationships;
- After major renovation work on the upper floors, which was finished mid 2008, Paramaribostraat 22 was rented out from 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2008.
- Many volunteers assisted the Stichting during the year.

### **Director and Board**

As at the end of 2008 the Stichting employed one director, who received remuneration. The Board consists of nine members who do not receive any remuneration from the Stichting.

After the decision of Mrs. J.M. Kohnert to step down from the directorship of the Stichting in April 2008, Mrs. E.M.C.J. van Holk was appointed as the new Director per 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2008.
